Directions

By Subway: Take the IRT No. 4 Lexington Ave. or the IND "D" line to the Bedford Park Blvd. Station. Walk west (left) to the campus.

By Car: Take the **Major Deegan Expressway (I-87)** to the Van Cortlandt Park exit. Follow signs to the college.

or the **Saw Mill/Henry Hudson Parkway** to the Mosholu Parkway exit. Take the right turn lane onto Dickinson Ave. Go one block and make a left then quick right onto Goulden Avenue. Three blocks to college—the gallery is at Gate 4.
