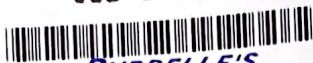

Jerome Park and Albania featured at gallery shows

The Lehman College Art Gallery will display "100 Years at Jerome Park Reservoir: A Photographic Essay" beginning July 10 through Sept. 8 at the gallery, Bedford Park Boulevard West off Goulden Avenue.

The photographs are by John Bartelstone, Sandra Sider and Robert Kornfeld Jr., a Riverdale resident. The show is sponsored by the college, the Jerome Park Conservancy, and the Parks Council, with help from Riverdalian Lorraine Hockett and the Spingold Foundation.

Also opening this month, photographer Stan Sherer will display his work in a show titled "Long Life to Your Children—A Portrait of High Albania" from

Mr. Sherer, who grew up in the Bronx, has visited Albania many times since it opened its borders to visitors in 1991. His black and white photographs convey the dignity of the Albanian people, the natural beauty of the Albanian landscape and the rigors of everyday life.

The exhibit is part of the gallery's ongoing series, "The Bronx Celebrates," which features the work of artists with Bronx roots.
